STAND North Dakota remains committed to serving Fargo through evidence-based treatment that reduces risks and enhances community safety. Our focus has always been on public safety, transparency, and working collaboratively with stakeholders.

There have been recent concerns that the presence of security cameras at the 2627 South University Drive location indicates that STAND has not been honest about our plans. That is not the case. These cameras are a reasonable and prudent measure to protect our building

STAND remains committed to finding a workable solution for our long-term service delivery location. We are actively exploring multiple options to ensure a long-term solution and are optimistic that we will soon have a resolution that allows us to stay in our current location. However, no final decision has been made regarding future operations at this location.

Our considerations have included:

- Exploring ways to remain at our current location while meeting our operational needs.
- Considering alternative locations for service delivery.
- Assessing how risk mitigation measures—such as modified hours and additional protocols—could allow for operation at University Drive, if needed.

We remain focused on our mission: reducing risks, preventing harm, and ensuring that individuals receive the accountability and treatment necessary to protect the community.
